Lectures and demonstrations are special events and are at your discretion. The pack does not have to stick together during the entire day. There will be many interesting things to see and trying to stay together as a large group may be difficult. Sticking with your den or smaller group may be more beneficial.

We will meet in the morning for a head count and to give out Scavenger Hunt sheets. Please be on time, there will be a lot to see and the group will be ready to get started sharply at 9:30am. If you have scheduling issues and know you will be arriving late, arrangements can be made with group leaders prior to that Sunday.

We can not assume that everyone will have cell service at the reenactment location so we can not rely on cellular communication for this event, this is why prior communication is important. If in the event that you are unable to meet at 9am and you are unable to establish contact with a leader we will try to leave lunch meeting location at the visitors center. (we can't promise they will allow this)

There is almost a half of a mile walk from the parking to the reenactment. Please be prepared with good walking shoes and strollers for our younger siblings and friends.

The event is rain or shine, the war and battle itself would not have been rescheduled or cancelled due to rain. Please be prepared with a poncho or rain slicker in case of inclement weather.

Parents and Cubs are encouraged to bring a backpack for the event. Cubs should pack their bags as if they are going on a hike (see your handbooks or ask your Den Leader) We suggest you bring your lunches in your backpacks, unless you want to take the long walk back to the parking area before lunch.

The following are suggested items for parents, Cubs, family, friends and guests of Pack 405:

- **Packed Lunch for Picnic (including drink)**
- **Small Blanket, Towel or Tarp (for resting on the ground and or picnic)**
- **Rain Slicker, Poncho or Umbrella**
- **Water Bottle**
- **Ear Plugs (for younger guests during the battle)**

You may want to wear a long-sleeved shirt underneath your uniform. Uniform hats are optional but if it's raining you may wear another hat. Remember to wear comfortable shoes and socks.
